Westside YMCA Monday – Friday 5:00am – 7:00pm Saturday – 7:00am-7:00pm Sunday – Closed for Deep Cleaning **Pools close 30 minutes prior to facility closing**

- We will be closed on Sunday's to allow for a deep clean of our facilities
- Sauna and Steam rooms will be closed
- Child Watch Services (Kids Gym and Tot Watch) will not be available.
