Sanitation Coordinator

General Function: The Sanitation Coordinator at the YMCA of Metropolitan Lansing oversees the general sanitation of their designated Y facility. Under the general direction of the Branch Executive, the incumbent will be responsible for the cleanliness of the buildings and facilities for the association. This is a hands-on position which serves as a member of the management team.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Recruits, hires, trains, develops, schedules and directs maintenance/housekeeping staff for the association. Reviews and evaluates performance. Develops strategies to motivate staff and achieve goals. Models relationship building skills in all interactions.
- 2. Help approve payroll for staff
- 3. Manges the daily activities of the different sites to include appropriate cleaning of all offices, bathrooms, program areas, pool areas, and other public spaces
- 4. Ensure sanitation of facilities abide by new COVID-19 requirement
- 5. Knowledge of OSHA and safety standards within the housekeeping department
- 6. Orders supplies as needed and maintains safe and appropriate storage.
- 7. Work with Vice President of Operations, Branch Executive, Regional Property Manager, and Facilities Committee to address facility and member concerns.
- 8. Help with sanitation needs throughout the organization, specifically at home branch which include wiping down counters, computers, office supplies, door knob/handles, handrails, lockers, elevator buttons, etc. if needed
- 9. Cability of working weekends and evenings if the need arises
- 10. Attend all required Association trainings and/or meetings.
- 11. Create a safe work environment thereby reducing the number of injuries and incidents.
- 12. Assist in the Annual Campaign as needed
- 13. Other duties as assigned

Salary: \$13-14/hr; part-time work schedule with a maximum of 28 hours a week

Benefits:

- Free YMCA Adult Membership
- 25% discount on program fees for themselves up to \$300 per year
- 12% retirement contribution upon eligibility
- Paid medical leave based on status and hours worked
- Paid YMCA risk required trainings

Job Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Minimum high school diploma
- Three years or more of experience in operations and maintenance of mechanical, structural, plumbing and electrical systems.
- Working knowledge of general maintenance, facility upkeep, repair and cleaning.
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills.
- Able to work with individuals from diverse backgrounds.
- Ability to cope with stress and demonstrate appropriate professional reaction to other's behaviors
- Completion of YMCA trainings within a required time frame. Trainings include:
 - CPR/AED, First Aid
 - Child Sexual Abuse
 - Harassment
 - $\circ \quad \text{Hazard} \quad$
 - Slips, Trips, and Falls
 - Blood Borne Pathogens

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is often required to: bend, stoop, kneel, twist, reach with hands, sit, stand for an extended period of time, lift and/or move up to 40 pounds, have finger dexterity, grasp, perform repetitive motions, talk, hear and have visual acuity.
