WHY MYSTIC LAKE CAMP?



CAMP DESCRIPTIONS

MYSTIC EXPERIENCE: The Mystic Experience program is where your child's camping traditions begin! Campers are placed in their cabin groups with children in the same age range and enjoy age appropriate activities. Each child will have the opportunity to make great friends, learn new skills, meet positive role models and leave our program with a higher level of confidence, maturity and understanding of our four core valueshonesty, caring, respect and responsibility.

GONE FISHING: You'll fish for pike, bass and pan fish, take a half-day charter on Lake Michigan to hook giant salmon, steelhead and lake trout, and compete in our bass tournament on Mystic Lake! Bring your tackle, we will supply bait and instruction. Campers also enjoy traditional activities, and will get to fry up some of their catch at the barbeque on Friday night. This is one of our most popular programs, and space is very limited. Register early.

TEEN NATION: Teens create their own camp experience with the guidance of their counselors. Activities are tailored to older campers and may include a ride on Bruno's Swing or a trip to the waterfront. The choice is theirs!

WRITE ON! CREATIVE WRITING CAMP: Let your imagination run wild and the words flow! Join author Amy Klco to sharpen your creative writing skills as you learn about writing hooks that catch your readers' attention, creating believable characters and settings to keep them reading, using dialogue to move your story along, and dynamic endings that will make them eager to read more.

TIER PRICING

LEADERS IN TRAINING: The LIT program introduces teens to the dynamics of leadership and team work. LITs will work closely with senior counselors to lead activities within their camp community.

COUNSELOR IN TRAINING: The CIT program is designed to train young people who are interested in potential future employment with Mystic Lake YMCA Camp. Weeks will be separated into growing leadership skills and working with senior counselors.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

FEE STRUCTURE

We realize families have differing abilities to pay for camp, so we have instituted a voluntary Three-Tier Fee program. This means you may choose the tier that best fits your family budget. All campers receive the same Y experience no matter what they pay. The Tier Pricing is described below. You must select one of the tiers during registration.

TIER A is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs.

TIER B is our partially subsidized fee for those who can pay a little more but still cannot afford the actual cost of camp.

TIER C accounts for the true costs of camp including wear and tear of buildings and grounds.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

A financial aid scholarship application is available on our website.

REGISTRATION FEE: A nonrefundable registration fee of \$100 is included in the camp fee and is required per session per child. The registration fee must accompany your camper registration.

BUS TRANSPORTATION: Bus seats are limited. \$30 to Camp and \$30 from Camp.
