HIGH ADVENTURE COORDINATOR

At Mystic Lake YMCA Camp, our goals are to teach youth social responsibility through environmental stewardship, community living, and working with one another in a group setting that builds friendships. Youth develop and learn new skills to improve their sense of self-worth and confidence in an accepting environment where all are welcome.

GENERAL FUNCTION

Under the supervision of the Senior Program Director, the High Adventure Coordinator is responsible for the supervision of all high ropes, rock wall, and giant swing activities. The High Adventure Coordinator is also responsible for reviewing safety procedures with all staff. Furthermore, the High Adventure Coordinator is responsible for planning, implementing, training, and evaluating all activities on courses.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Staff must be at least 21 years of age with current certification from Experiential Systems Incorporated. An understanding of the Association of Challenge Course Technology standards is also required.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Attend staff training and teach operation procedures to staff who will assist high adventure staff
2. Administer group use of challenge courses
3. Review emergency communication systems at the courses and train staff in their use
4. Conduct a weekly and monthly safety inspection of the program areas and submit a risk management report to the Senior Program Director, including notes on hazardous conditions which need correction
5. Review and post all safety rules
6. Conduct in-service trainings
7. Supervise staff working in areas, providing instruction and corrective feedback when necessary
8. Perform other duties as assigned

MEASUREMENT OF PERFORMANCE

1. Campers and staff will know challenge course policies and procedures.
2. Campers will have a positive challenge experience.
3. Certified staff will consistently demonstrate knowledge of skills

SALARY/HOURS/BENEFITS
