SPARK Instructor

General Function: Under the supervision of the Association Outreach Coordinator, the SPARK Instructor will provide instruction and leadership with the SPARK curriculum for designated sites where SPARK is being taught. The delivery of the curriculum will be focused on building relationships with students, parents, site administration and overall community. This position will create weekly; quality lesson plans using the resources provided that will be followed. This position will be teaching within the Lansing Public Schools two days a week, 11:30am-1:30pm as well as supporting the YMCA program initiatives.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Deliver SPARK curriculum at designated sites.
- 2. Creating weekly lesson plans and attending all staff meetings.
- 3. Keeping proper inventory records.
- 4. Leader in health and wellness initiatives.
- 5. Ensure a positive delivery and encouraging environment with co-workers and participants.
- 6. Establish systems for regularly scheduled equipment inspections to ensure proper replacement and safety of all participants.
- 7. Ongoing relationship building with partnering organizations, community leaders, donors, parents and kids.
- 8. Support SPARK programming by participating in community events.
- 9. Other duties as assigned

Salary: \$20/hr for school year programming & \$15 for all other SPARK activities; part-time work schedule with a maximum of 28 hours a week

Benefits:

- Free YMCA Adult Membership
- 25% discount on program fees for themselves up to \$300 per year
- 12% retirement contribution upon eligibility
- Paid medical leave based on status and hours worked
- Paid YMCA risk required trainings

Job Requirements:

- Bachelor of Science degree preferably in exercise physiology, exercise science, kinesiology, physical education or related field. Equivalent combination of education and experience accepted.
- Possess a valid driver's license.
- Knowledge of physical education/exercise encouraged
- Must have a dynamic engaging personality with strong relationship building skills.
- Possess strong organizational and communication skills.
- Strong teaching skills.
- Strong self-starter and ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office and experience with databases.
- Ability to track, record and ensure privacy of participant for data collection.
- Promote and represent the mission and core values of the YMCA of Lansing.
- Must be available for some evening and weekend community events.
- Completion of YMCA trainings within a required time frame. Trainings include:
 - o CPR/AED, First Aid
 - Child Sexual Abuse
 - Harassment
 - Hazard
 - Slips, Trips, and Falls
 - Blood Borne Pathogens

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is often required to: bend, stoop, kneel, twist, reach with hands, sit, stand for an extended period of time, lift and/or move up to 40 pounds, have finger dexterity, grasp, perform repetitive motions, talk, hear and have visual acuity.
