POSITION SUMMARY:

The Assistant Teacher is responsible for assisting the lead teacher in the supervision and management of all children within a classroom.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Under the leadership of the lead teacher, plan and prepare activities that are developmentally appropriate for the children in your classroom, adhering to research-based child development principles.
- Supervise children and manage the classroom according to the lead teacher's plans and the center's guidelines when the lead teacher is absent.
- Demonstrate affection and support to children and share relevant information with their families to maintain positive relations between them and the center.
- Foster your own professional development by maintaining open communication with lead teachers and other coworkers.
- Ensure the safety of children through constant supervision (by sight and sound), effective arrangement of space, proper maintenance of equipment, and regular practice of emergency drills and procedures. Understand and abide by all licensing requirements pertaining to care of children and maintenance of the classroom environment.
- Collaborate with and offer assistance to lead teachers and coworkers.
- Contribute to the Lansing YMCA's culture and operations by participating fully in staff meetings, sharing information obtained through outside reading and training, and performing other duties as required.

SALARY & HOURS: Part-time/non-exempt; \$14-\$16/hour based on experience; max. 39 hours per week.

- Demonstrated abilities in active listening and conflict resolution. Good writing skills preferred.
- Have a warm, supportive attitude toward children and families of all cultures.
- Demonstrated willingness to follow instructions in emergency situations.
- Must have the ability to pass a comprehensive background check (including fingerprinting) prior to employment and intermittently thereafter. R 400.8112(1)
- Verification of negative TB status obtained within one year prior to employment. R 400.8128
- Evidence of continuing study in the field of Early Childhood Education preferred.

WORK ENVIRONMENT & PHYSICAL DEMANDS: While performing the duties of this job, the employee is often required to: bend, stoop, kneel, twist, reach with hands, sit, stand for an extended period, lift and/or move up to 30 pounds, have finger dexterity, grasp, perform repetitive motions, speak, hear, and have visual acuity.
